Late applications will not be considered. Current seniors are not eligible to apply. Scholarships will not be awarded to any musician in consecutive years.

About our benefactor, Lorne Schnell, Kankakee (1933-2000) ~ Music was a life-long passion of Mr. Schnell, and he believed in the uplifting power of music for those who made music a part of their lives. He was an accomplished violinist and jazz musician, and also enjoyed restoring violins. He served on the board of directors and was a former member of Kankakee County Symphony. A founding member of the Kankakee Valley Youth Symphony Orchestra, it was Mr. Schnell and his family's wish to encourage and support music education for the youth in our area.

In honor of Mr. Schnell, the KVYSO will choose 5 applicants to receive a \$500 scholarship. Successful candidates will be chosen on the basis of attendance, attitude, musicianship, the recommendation of a private music teacher, and those in good financial standing.

Awards for Study Scholarships will be made at the spring concert. It is expected that the Study Scholarship winners will return to the KVYSO the following season.
